
SO WHAT'S IN THE DETAIL?

◀ **Recaro seats.** Corsa VXR Arctic Edition comes with figure-hugging, height adjustable Recaro shell-backed sports front seats. They'll give you all the support you need when the going gets quick. And they look like they mean business too.



Black detailing. Contrast is where it's at. Corsa VXR Arctic Edition is only available in white. So those electrically heated door mirrors are only available in black. The rear glass is dark-tinted too. Not to mention the black roof panel. Matches the wheels. Do we see a theme developing here?



Sports exhaust. All Corsa VXR Arctic Editions come provided with the optional Remus Sports exhaust system, providing a significant performance increase of up to 15PS. The Corsa VXR centre exit sports exhaust is also tuned for a great sound.



◀ ▲ **Arctic interior.** The Corsa VXR interior already comes with a sporting accent, thanks to all its VXR-specific detailing, leather-trimmed steering wheel and gear knob with VXR badges, alloy sports pedals and more. And the black sports instruments come with translucent rings and red highlights. Corsa VXR Arctic Edition adds white facia air vent surrounds and numbered facia-mounted identifier plaque for a unique look.



Corsa VXR. Does it need an introduction? 0-60mph in 6.8 seconds. 192PS with software controlled overboost for up to 260+Nm of torque. 
