Chevette.

A great name in value motoring.

Few cars have so consistently held popular esteem as the Vauxhall Chevette.

Stylish, economical to run, great fun to drive, with four seater comfort, generous load space and well proven reliability, it's easy to see why the Chevette is consistently among the top selling cars in the UK.

Its appeal is wide, attractive to young and experienced drivers both male and female. Its 1300 engine produces plenty of power when you need it; its roadholding and handling still set it apart from more mundane competitors – and has helped turn the Chevette into one of the most successful of all national and international rally cars.

Precise rack and pinion steering, all-coil spring suspension and servo-assisted dual circuit brakes add to the Chevette's renowned nippy handling and ride comfort, whether driving spiritedly or just pottering about.

All the Chevette's virtues are in evidence in three body styles: smart saloons, sporty hatchbacks and capacious estates, each cleverly combining passenger roominess with generous load space.

The Chevette Saloon for instance, seats four comfortably and offers a surprisingly large boot of over 14 cubic feet.

Depending on the model you choose, there are four levels of trim and equipment to ensure that there's a Chevette that's just right – from the super value ES through to the luxurious GL.

And there's a choice of 11 smart colours, including four metallic finishes, for E, L and GL models.

What's more, if you like the extra refinement of automatic transmission, you can specify that too on Chevette L and GL.



Thoroughly refined plus dependable virtues.



Chevette styling has that timeless sort of appeal that in saloon, estate or hatchback form is unmistakably Chevette.

The saloon is just over 13½ feet long and is a spacious four seater with a vast 14.3 cu. ft. boot. There are two and four door models and on the former, wide opening doors and forward tilting front seats give easy access to the rear compartment.

The Chevette Estate's high lifting tailgate opens up to reveal a floor that's completely flat right up to the tailgate aperture. Raising or lowering the rear seat takes only seconds to give you the choice of 21.9 cu.ft. or 39.6 cu.ft. of load space.

Sporty

Chevette Hatch offers the same sort of versatility coupled to sporty style. Its compact dimensions plus light steering and controls—a special Chevette feature—make the hatch ideal for town work; it slots into the tightest spots without drama. Yet the Chevette Hatch is also a quiet and effortless motorway cruiser with its lively 1256cc engine.

Although there are three styles of Chevette, all share the same high standards of engineering excellence.

That the Chevette's rear wheel drive is supremely efficient is endorsed by the countless wins of the highly-developed Dealer Team Vauxhall Chevettes in national and international rallies.

Automatic

The Chevette is one of the very few cars of its size and power available with automatic transmission.

And it has what is widely acknowledged as the very best: GM 3-speed automatic.

Available on L and GL models, it brings an entirely new flavour to driving this class of car.

If you like your driving ultra relaxed, this is the automatic to try.





More luxury with driver appeal.

In the Chevette's lifespan, the comparatively few exterior detail changes have underlined the 'rightness' of the original design. Current interiors though, are plusher and more luxurious than ever and still retain all the virtues of comfort and space that make the Chevette so tireless to drive or ride in.

Front seats are shaped to give plenty of lateral support and there's generous fore and aft movement so that you can achieve the ideal driving position.

At the wheel

Undoubtedly, the Chevette pleases drivers. From the moment you grip the small diameter sports steering wheel to letting your left hand drop easily to the stubby gear lever, everything feels right and looks workmanlike.

On the move, the rack and pinion steering is highly responsive; the Chevette goes precisely where it's pointed. The slick-action gearchange invariably draws favourable comment with its short 'throw.'

Behind the wheel, a neat console houses the instruments with at-a-glance legibility. Primary controls such as headlamp dip/flash, horn, turn indicators, wipers and screenwash are all within fingertip reach.

On the left are the smooth slide controls for the versatile heating and ventilation system, which includes twin cool air adjustable centre vents in the fascia and side window demist vents.

Now, the Chevette strengthens even further those values which have earned this Vauxhall so much acclaim from so many satisfied owners.

Chevette ES & E

When first introduced at the N.E.C. Motor Show in 1980, the Chevette ES specification coupled to its price created a sensation. It is still sensational!

Here's a car that embodies all the style and engineering refinement of the Chevette range at a price that makes it one of the 'best buys' in the UK.

Available as a 2-door saloon or 3-door hatch, it offers four-seater comfort, big load carrying capability, exceptional driving ease and great all-round economy.

In addition, it has a standard of handling and roadholding that makes it a pleasure to drive.

The lively, well-proven 1256cc engine is coupled to a slick 4-speed gearbox with a short 'throw' that makes for crisp action. Front disc and rear drum brakes with servo assistance, all-coil suspension with front anti-roll bar, plus light-action rack and pinion steering endorse the superb value of the Chevette ES.

Chevette E

The Chevette E opens up a choice of three styles - 2 or 4-door saloons, 3-door hatch or 3-door estate. Saloons and hatchbacks have Piper Check cloth upholstery whilst the E Estate - usually chosen as a hard-working load carrier - has highly durable Vynide trim.

There's wider choice too in colours, with the full range of eleven acrylic paint finishes to choose from including four metallic finishes.

The E Saloon will appeal to those who prefer traditional lines - with the bonus of big luggage capacity.

The beauty of the hatch is its versatility - all the comfort of a saloon plus extra load carrying ability with the rear seat folded. In that layout the Chevette Hatch has a floor length of 58.5in and a width of 50.5in.

If load carrying ability is the first priority, look into a Chevette E Estate - purpose designed and offering up to 39.6 cu.ft. of load space.



Chevette L

Chevette L models provide that blend of extra refinement and comfort to make them outstandingly popular. Available as 2 or 4-door sedans, 3-door hatch or 3-door estate, the Chevette L has Donegal Tweed cloth upholstery, reclining front seats, manual-tune radio and additional sound insulation among its many refinements.

There's no shortage of comfort and convenience features either, with a driver's door pocket to hold a host of oddments, a vanity mirror and quartz-activated clock.

On the road, you'll appreciate the dipping rear view mirror and wipers with intermittent wipe action, together with a heated rear window, radial ply tyres, reverse lights and hazard warning flashers.

In addition to GM automatic, you can specify a wide range of optional equipment at extra cost.

Three particularly popular options are a transparent removable sun roof, front seat head restraints and a load compartment cover that provides extra security. (See page 15).



Chevette GL

This is the Chevette that proves a luxury car need not necessarily be big. Discreet extra brightwork, body side protection mouldings and distinctive wheels immediately identify this top model either in 4-door saloon form or as a 3-door hatch.

Inside, Dapple Velour upholstery confirms the luxury. Front seat head restraints are adjustable for height and angle. A push-button radio is a GL feature, together with a cigar lighter, centre console and tray.

In addition to cloth inserts, lower door sections are carpeted to obviate scuffing and both front doors have useful pockets. The Saloon has a boot mat and a boot light, whilst the GL Hatchback has a fully-carpeted load deck and hinged load cover.

Extensive colour-keying throughout enhances the light airy spaciousness of the Chevette GL, which combines top luxury with high standards of overall running economy.

On the road, the all-coil spring suspension, light and precise rack and pinion steering, plus servo-assisted brakes with front discs, give the Chevette a 'driveability' that inspires total confidence.





1. Third Party Liability

Unlimited indemnity including law costs, is provided for the following—

- Any licensed driver driving with the Insured's consent.
- The Insured whilst driving any other car not belonging to him.*
- Insured's liability to passengers. At the request of the Insured the underwriters will indemnify passengers travelling in the insured car in respect of any injury or damage caused by their negligence.

2. Legal Advice and Defence

Free legal defence will be provided in the case of proceedings in a court of summary jurisdiction and for the defence of charges of manslaughter or reckless or dangerous driving causing death, where such charges arise from an event which is the subject of indemnity under this policy.

3. Foreign Travel and Transit

Covered in full whilst the car is being used on the Continent of Europe subject to prior notice to the underwriters and payment of an additional premium. Transit is covered between any ports in Great Britain, Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man and the Channel Islands and/or any ports on the Continent of Europe by recognised sea passage of no longer duration than 65 hours.

4. Bonus

If one claim is made in the preceding years a 50% or 60% bonus will revert to 30% or 40% respectively. Two claims in the preceding year will result in the complete loss of bonus.

5. Guaranteed Bonus*

Underwriters will allow a 60% no claim bonus on all future renewals regardless of the number of claims made, provided the Insured has earned a 60% no claim bonus with The H.P. Motor Policies at Lloyd's for at least the two preceding years. This benefit does not apply if (1) any claim is made whilst the vehicle is being driven by or is in the charge of any person who is a learner driver or under the age of 25, (2) this contract is not in the name of an individual.

6. Fire and Theft

Loss of or damage to the insured car, including accessories and spare parts, caused by fire or theft is covered up to the market value.

7. Replacement Car*

At the request of the Insured, cars less than 12 months old from the date of first registration as new, will be replaced if (a) they are stolen and not recovered, or (b) the cost of repairs exceeds 50% of its list price when new. Subject to availability in the United Kingdom.

8. Value

In the event of the total loss or destruction of the insured motor vehicle the underwriters will pay the current market value of the insured car at the time of such loss or destruction. Subject to 7 above.

9. Audio Equipment

The Underwriters' liability in respect of loss of or damage to radio cassette players, cassette players, tape decks or citizen band radio equipment shall be limited to the market value at the time of such loss or damage, but in no case shall it exceed the sum of £100 any one claim.

10. Accidental Damage to Car

Covered in full (including accessories, spare parts, and spare tyres and reasonable cost of removal of car to and from repairer). Accessories other than Audio equipment (see 9) are covered in full.

11. Medical Expenses

Up to £100 paid for fees incurred by insured driver or any passenger in the car.

12. Accidents to Owner and Spouse*

Between the ages of 15 and 65. Accidental death or disablement in connection with any private motor car—£5,000 for death, loss of two eyes or two limbs. £2,500 for loss of 1 eye or 1 limb.

13. Rugs, Clothing and Personal Effects*

Loss by theft or fire or accidental means of rugs, clothing and personal effects. Limit £100 any one occurrence.

14. Garage

Up to £200 for loss or damage by fire, lightning or explosion to the structure of the insured vehicle's garage provided the garage is owned by the Insured or he is legally liable for it and it is not otherwise insured.

15. Repairs

The Insured may give instructions for any repairs necessary to be commenced, provided a detailed estimate is sent forthwith to the Underwriters for their approval, but the Underwriters reserve to themselves the right to decline, invite or accept estimates.

Joint Ownership*

In the case of joint owners the driving of other cars is excluded, and the owner's personal accident benefits included in the comprehensive policy are only payable pro rata, according to the number of owners. In such cases, the reduction for 'One named driver' and 'More than one car' are not allowed.

Drivers under 25 and any driver who has not held a permanent driving licence for a period of 12 months or drivers who have held a licence issued outside Great Britain, Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man or the Channel Islands for a period of less than two years are subject to a special clause whereby Underwriters are not liable for the first £35 of any damage to the insured vehicle. This amount is increased to £75 if the driver is under 21 years of age.


