## PANDA *Comfort*

The Comfort is the latest addition to the immensely popular Panda range.

At its heart is a highly developed 903 cc, 45 bhp engine that's undergone significant improvements to the carburettor, distributor and air filter.

As you would expect from Fiat, it's reliable, economical\* and easy to start. (Particularly useful on cold, wet winter mornings.)

There's also an improved rear suspension which makes for a smoother, more comfortable ride on even the roughest roads.

Inside, the seats are both comfortable and hardwearing, being covered in a blue mixed tweed cloth which is carried over on to the doors, as well as the front parcel shelf.

There's a one piece roof lining and the black dashboard incorporates a new switch

for the electrically operated rear wash wipe.

(Note that the windscreen washers are also electrically operated.)

The rear parcel shelf is attached by straps to the top of the tailgate so that when you lift the hatchback the parcel shelf automatically lifts as well.

In every other respect the Comfort is a typical Panda. Compact, spacious, practical and versatile.

In addition ownership includes a year's free Motoring Membership of the RAC and the reassurance of a six year anti-corrosion warranty.†

To test drive one, simply visit your Fiat dealer.

You'll discover, perhaps for the first time, that a compact car can indeed be comfortable.
