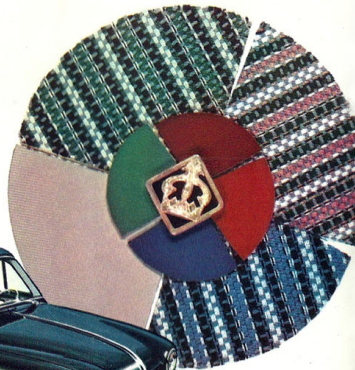
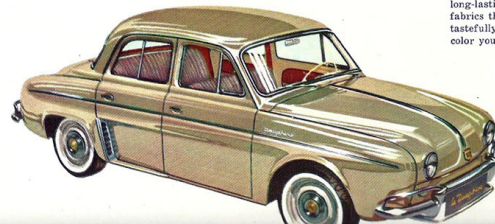
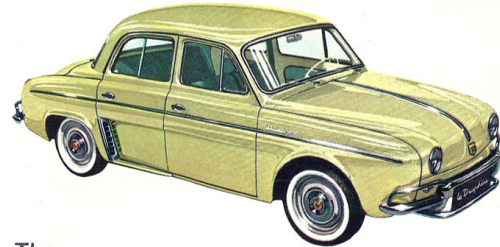
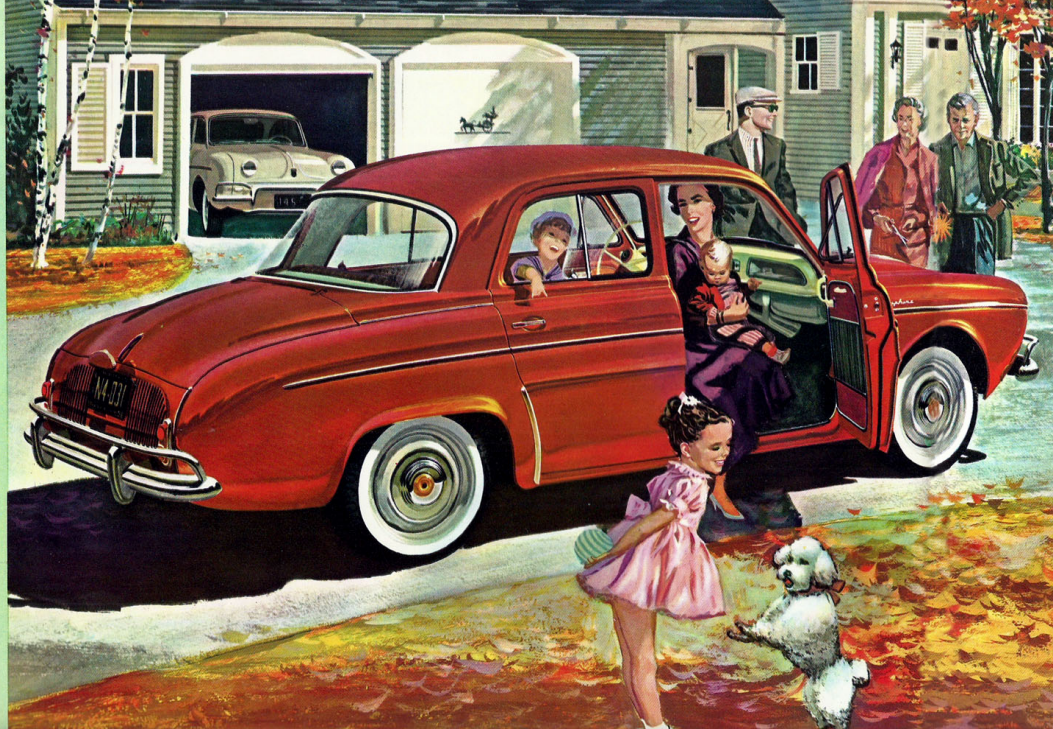
"SPACE-PLANNED" FOR COMFORT!

The Dauphine's rear-mounted, 4-cylinder engine is unexcelled in its field. Combining lively performance with outstanding economy and dependability, the Ventoux has delighted owners and automotive experts alike with its instant acceleration and responsive flow of power in all gears. A highly efficient pressurized radiator system is especially designed to meet the engine's cooling needs under all motoring conditions . . . *it cannot overheat!* Thick rubber body mounts cushion the engine and transmission and contribute to the Dauphine's quiet, vibration-free ride. The Dauphine's powerful "safety-swift" hydraulic brakes are truly outstanding. They provide positive action and smooth straight-line stops with little pedal pressure. Large brake drums and generous lining areas *prevent fading*, even under the most rigorous demands. Streamlined body, efficient engine design, and excellent power-to-weight ratio are among the contributing factors in the Dauphine's amazing record run of 43 MILES OF DRIVING on just ONE GALLON OF GAS.

An independent four-wheel suspension is the underlying reason for the Dauphine's solid stability, amazing handling ease, and road-hugging ability. Each wheel is free to react individually to road variations resulting in a smoother, more balanced ride. **Front Suspension.** Cushioned with large coil springs and direct acting shock absorbers it effectively absorbs road shocks and minimizes wheel hopping. A *torsional stabilizer bar* controls body sway on turns. **Rear Suspension.** Large, steel shock absorbers are mounted above the axis of the coil springs and close to the wheels for fast, smooth action. Adding to the stabilizing effect of the rear suspension is the placement of the 4-point engine mountings.

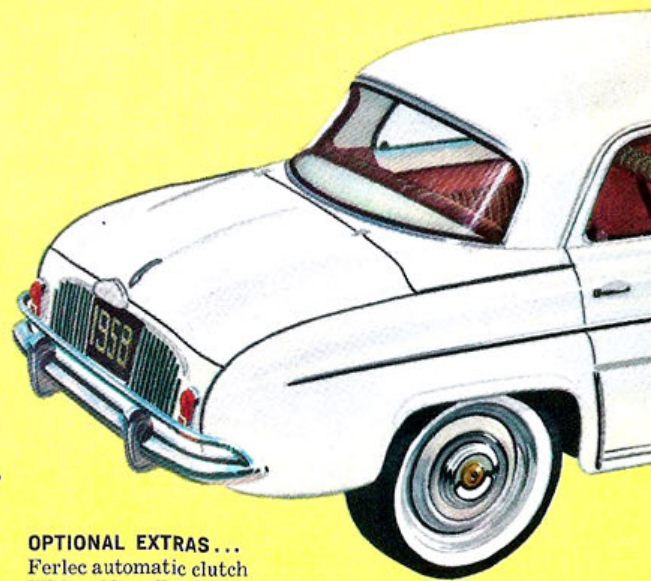
