Take the cross traffic assist at the rear, which alerts the driver to the risk of a possible collision when leaving a parking space. In particularly dangerous situations, the emergency assist can help to keep the vehicle in lane if the driver becomes unresponsive and to brake the vehicle to a standstill if necessary. In conjunction with S tronic, adaptive cruise control Stop&Go keeps the vehicle at a constant distance from the vehicle in front. And the congestion assist takes over the steering work at speeds of up to 65 km/h, thus making life easier in stop-and-go traffic.

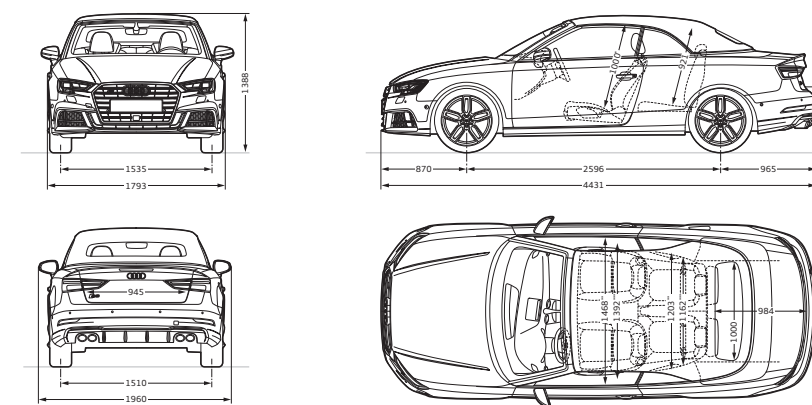
