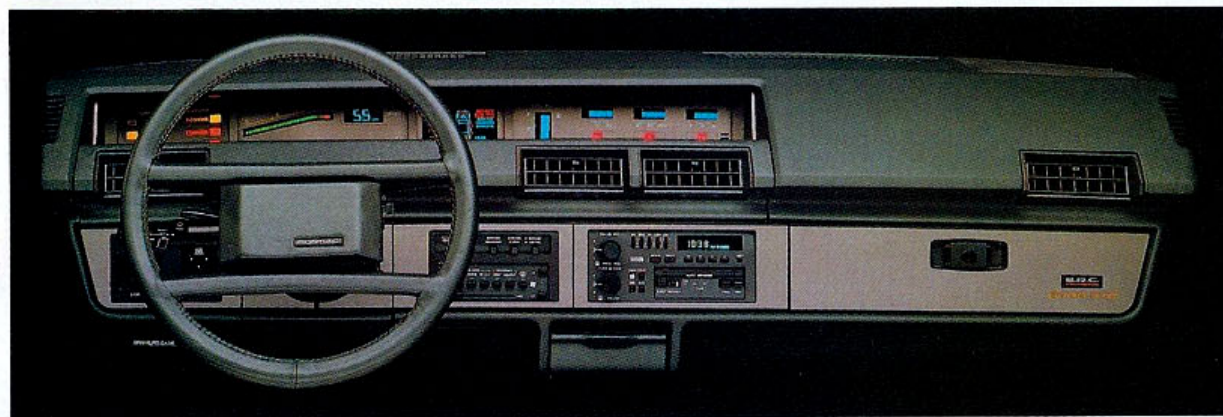

PONTIAC 6000 STE: AMERICA'S ULTIMATE PERFORMANCE SEDAN.

Just one year ago, the Pontiac 6000 Special Touring Edition made its debut to resounding applause and critical acclaim. It has since become North America's ultimate performance sedan. But, as always, Pontiac engineers were not content to rest on their laurels. The result is a more refined, improved and technically advanced 6000 STE for 1984.

A digital speedometer and analog tachometer are new features on the STE's all electronic instrument panel. Instruments in Canada are metric where required.

six ways. Headrests are designed into both front and rear seating areas. And the four-spoke steering wheel is leather-wrapped to provide a comfortable grip.

The 6000 STE is the most thoroughly equipped car in Pontiac history. A partial list of standard features includes a high-performance AM/FM stereo cassette with a graphic equalizer, power windows, cruise control, side window defoggers, electronically controlled twin outside mirrors and a remote trunk release.

On the subject of trunks, it should be noted that the STE's is more than just a barren steel storage bin. It's fully carpeted, holds a compact spare tire, an accessory kit and a unique device called an inflator, that does just that to items like tires and sports equipment.

However, these wonderments alone do not make a driver's car. The nuts and bolts which combine to make the Pontiac 6000 STE a precise driving machine include finely-tuned shock absorbers, springs and bushings. Front wheel drive. Stabilizer bars both front and rear. MacPherson strut front suspension. Power rack-and-pinion steering. Power four wheel disc brakes. A three-speed automatic transmission. And specially selected 195/70R14 Goodyear Eagle GT's mounted on ventilated cast aluminum wheels.

All of this technological finery is powered by a smooth, responsive 2.8 litre High Output V-6 engine.

The Pontiac 6000 STE: Built for the exhilarating business of serious driving.

Appearance alone lends a subtle hint that the 6000 STE is a state-of-the-art automobile. Four halogen head lamps and two inboard mounted fog lamps grace the front of its aerodynamic wedge shape, while pleasing tone-on-tone paint, tasteful trim, blacked out taillamps and dual outlet stainless steel exhaust pipes add greater definition to its sophisticated character.

Inside, the cues are even stronger. A new electronic instrument panel glows with specific

data relayed from a digital speedometer and analog tachometer. The panel also features a Driver Information Centre which uses words and pictures to monitor important mechanical functions, vital fluid levels and regular maintenance intervals.

The fact that serious consideration was given to the interior design of the 6000 STE is evident. Rich fabric seats are supportive, not cushy. The driver's seat reclines fully and adjusts manually

The Pontiac 6000 has a clean, tailored look. Dual rectangular headlamps are mounted above an integral body-colored front bumper. Window frames, side mirrors, rocker panels and trim are all finished in a rich matte black. Taillamps wrap snugly around the rear fenders. Overall, the 6000's low front end, high rear deck and lean profile make it look good from every angle.

But, its real character is evident the moment you take it to the streets. MacPherson

strut front suspension, power rack and pinion steering, rear trailing arm suspension, and front and rear stabilizer bars give Pontiac 6000 a remarkable feel for the road. While the standard 2.5 litre 4-cylinder "swirl-port" engine with electronic fuel injection, coupled with its automatic transmission delivers responsive performance.

PONTIAC 6000 LE. Open the door of the Pontiac 6000 LE and you're immediately welcomed by luxury. The standard notchback front seat is covered in a thick cloth and offers a fold-down armrest for added comfort. A four-spoke

luxury cushion steering wheel helps provide a sure grip. And map pockets are conveniently placed on front doors and seatbacks.

You can choose from a long list of available features on the 6000 LE including air conditioning, removable glass sunroof, trunk-mounted luggage rack and a rear-mounted power antenna.

PONTIAC 6000 WAGON. The clean, crisp lines of our Pontiac 6000 have been extended to create what may be one of the most beautiful and functional station wagons ever. Introducing the Pontiac 6000 Wagon,



the car that delivers plenty of room *and* genuine driving excitement.

Front-wheel-drive gives it the traction. A 2.5 litre 4-cylinder "swirl-port" engine with electronic fuel injection gives it the power. And the combination of a responsive suspension system, power rack and pinion steering and power front disc brakes gives it a responsive performance.

Pack it with people, fill it with freight. The 6000 Wagon gives you the option. You have a choice of seating for up to eight adults. When you fold down the back seat you'll find 2106 litres (74.4 cubic feet) to stow and haul whatever your heart desires.

PONTIAC 6000 LE WAGON. If you prefer more luxury, the 6000 LE Wagon is right for you. The cut-pile carpeting is thick and full. The seats are covered in fine fabric. Map pockets and acoustical insulation enhance its rich and roomy environment. And a remote control tailgate release adds convenience to its luxury.

Woodgrain trim (above right), wire wheels, a rear window wiper and roof rack are just a few available options. You also have a choice of an available 2.8 litre V-6 or 4.3 litre V-6 diesel engine. The Pontiac 6000: It just may be North America's ultimate driver's wagon.

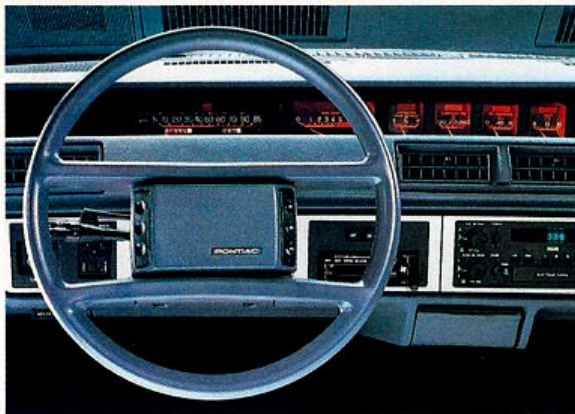
An available landau roof shown below gives the Pontiac 6000 LE Coupe a more formal look.
