A WORD ABOUT ASSEMBLY, COMPONENTS AND OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT IN THESE PONTIAC PRODUCTS.

The Pontiacs described in this brochure are assembled at facilities of General Motors Corporation operated by GM of Canada. These vehicles incorporate thousands of different components produced by various divisions of General Motors and by various suppliers to General Motors. From time to time during the manufacturing process, it may be necessary, in order to meet public demand for particular vehicles or equipment, or to meet federally mandated emissions, safety and fuel economy requirements, or for other reasons, to produce Pontiac products with different components or differently sourced components than initially scheduled. All such components have been approved for use in Pontiac products

and will provide the quality performance associated with the Pontiac name.
