**T**HE MYSTIQUE OF GRAND PRIX. One look reveals its lineage. The proud stance. The tailored cut. Styling with a strength that is unmistakably Grand Prix, the personal luxury Pontiac.

The sloping, low front and raised rear deck give Grand Prix a wind-cheating, wedge-shape appearance telling you immediately that here is a car built not just to pamper six people, but to do it efficiently.

You have four ways to enrich your driving experience.

Grand Prix, that puts true luxury within the reach of more people. Grand Prix LJ, the super-luxury Pontiac.

Grand Prix Brougham with Prima knit velour split seats in a loose-pillow design.

And, new for '82, the Grand Prix Brougham Landau that includes a landau roof top with heavy padding and opera lamps, power windows and luxury carpeting, special acoustical insulation, custom wheel covers and other distinctive touches to make the good life even better.

All Grand Prix models have standard notchback seats with a pull-down centre armrest. Some are just more luxurious than others. For instance, the Grand Prix Broughams' notchbacks are split 60/40 for personal convenience. Grand Prix and Grand Prix LJ have split seats available and also offer optional reclining buckets for the sporty feeling that's a Grand Prix tradition.

An even-firing 3.8 litre V6 is the standard engine, providing a sensible

balance of power and performance. Available engines are a four-barrel 4.1 litre V6, a compact 4.4 litre V8 and a 5.7 litre Diesel V8 with that special fuel miserliness of a Diesel.

Whichever engine you choose, one thing you can look forward to is that luxurious Grand Prix ride. A full coil suspension system puts a coil spring that's been computer-selected for your specific model with your specific equipment at each wheel.

But Grand Prix wouldn't be a Pontiac if it didn't offer a full measure of practicality. For example, the anti-corrosion measures. Two basic steps are taken to help protect your new Grand Prix from the elements. First, we designed-out areas critical to corrosion damage by providing drainage and eliminating pockets that collect moisture and debris. Second, we designed-in structural materials and barriers that are especially impervious to corrosion. Plus we used many final finishing procedures like zinc-rich primers and Plastisol lower-body stone/chip protection to help make sure your Grand Prix is built to last. Please check with your dealer about the unlimited mileage, Three-Year Perforation-from-Corrosion Limited Warranty.

Also, see your Pontiac dealer for details and information about GM's 24-month/24,000 mile Power Protection Plus Limited Warranty on the powertrain. For added peace-of-mind motoring, be sure to ask about the available GM Continuous Protection Plan option.

Pontiac wants you to enjoy your 1982 Grand Prix as one of the best new-car investments you have ever made. And we want you to enjoy it for a long time.
