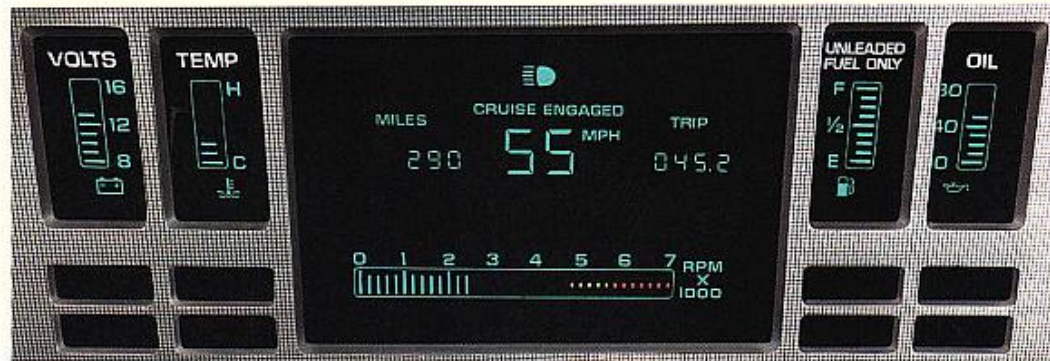

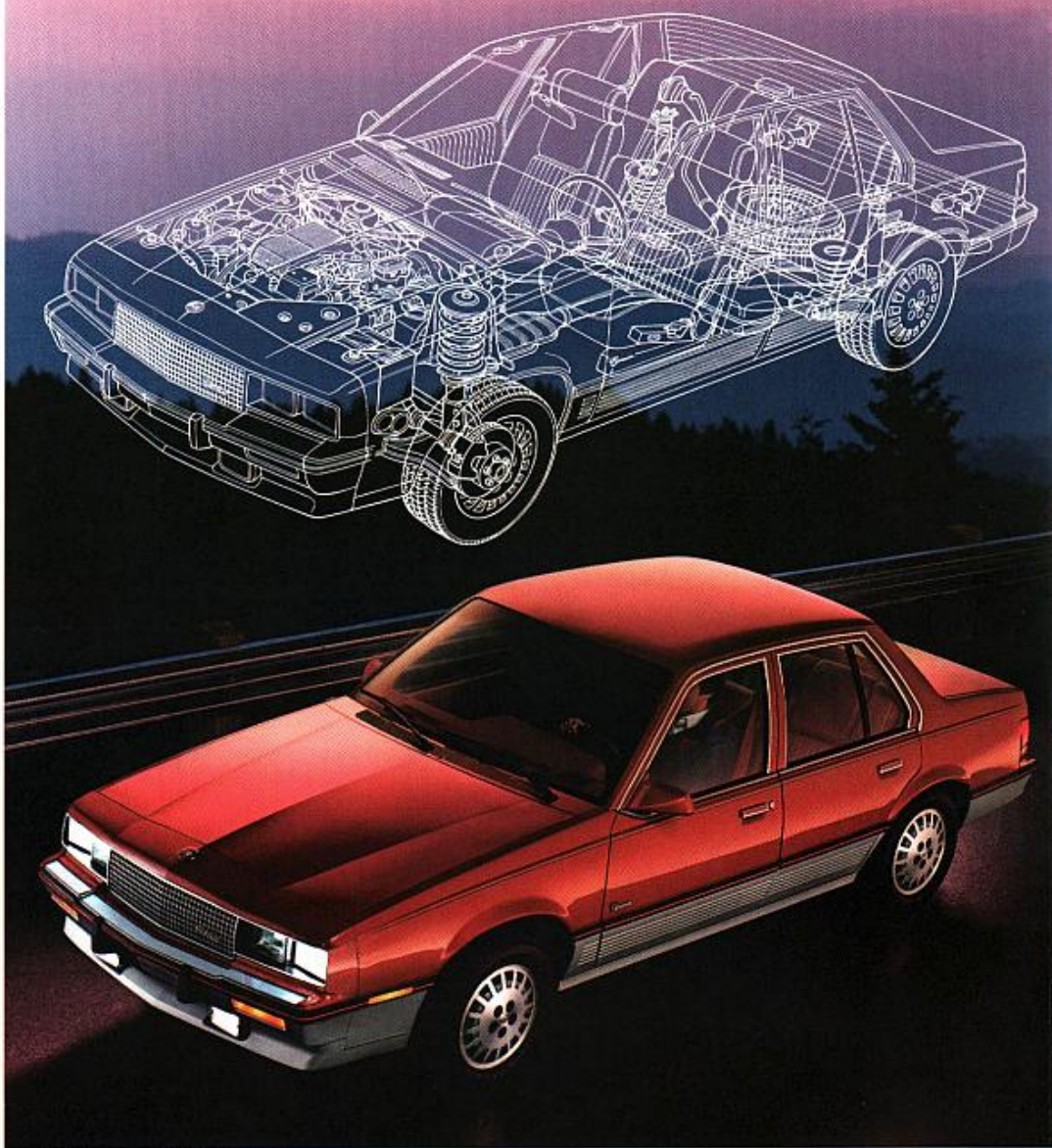

Balanced. Responsive. Quick. That's what you'll say when you drive the new V6 Cimarron.

Responsive 2.8 Liter V6. It's 173 cubic inches of fast-burn, swirl-port technology designed to squeeze power out of every sip of fuel. It's fed by sophisticated multi-port fuel injection (MFI). Each of the engine's six cylinders receives fuel from its own precision injector. This fuel management system, along with ram air intake tuning, delivers high power and torque along with quick throttle response and smooth, quiet operation.

An electronic mass air flow sensor measures the mass (rather than volume) of incoming air, and generates an electronic signal to help control air-fuel mixtures precisely.

When you order the available V6 engine, you can choose between the standard four-speed manual transmission with overdrive or the available three-speed automatic.

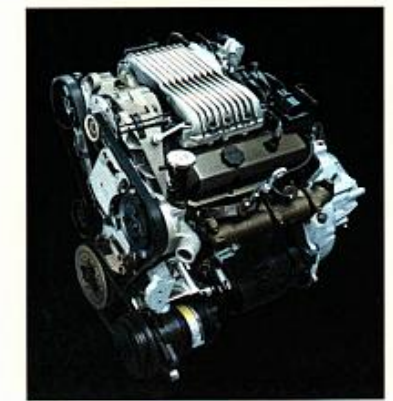
Balanced Gas-Charged Suspension. Its design complements the V6 engine, and is required when you order it. In front, Delco twin-tube MacPherson struts hold inert nitrogen gas under pressure. Not only does this reduce fluid aeration to improve damping, it actually increases the tractive effort of the strut (its tendency to extend fully), which helps plant each wheel more firmly on the road. Bilstein-Delco nitrogen gas-charged shock absorbers in the rear reduce fluid aeration, improve damping and increase tractive effort to improve rebound control. Completing this package are stiffer front springs and a larger-diameter stabilizer bar than those used on the standard suspension. And once you drive it, you'll understand what we mean when we say "balanced."

Sporty available 14" Wheels and Goodyear Eagle GT Tires. Enhance the appearance of a 1986 Cimarron with available 14" aluminum alloy wheels. They're surrounded by aggressive-looking Goodyear Eagle GT P205/60R14 low-profile, high-performance, steel-belted radial black-wall tires.

You may like the appearance of these same tires with raised white outline letters. If you do, they're available.

Prefer the 2.0 Liter four-cylinder? Read on. There's a very measured, high-technology efficiency surrounding the standard 2.0 Liter four-cylinder engine. Many drivers like its miserly ways with fuel and its inherent simplicity. Perhaps you're a driver who appreciates these virtues. If you are, then this section is for you.

Consider this: the air conditioner compressor. Normally, this is a power-robbing device, but the special design compressor used for Cimarron actually increases usable power without increasing power output. Instead of a constant-displacement design (common on many compressors), Cimarron is equipped with a variable-displacement V5 compressor

that actually senses the refrigerant pressure and changes the displacement to match evaporator requirements.

On a warm day, when cooling requirements are greatest, the compressor's displacement is greatest (at 9.5 cubic inches). On days when cooling requirements are less, the compressor automatically reduces displacement (down to as low as one cubic inch).

This reduced displacement draws less power from the engine, enhancing the driving feel. And there's another benefit: that Cadillac feel, because the variable-displacement design permits the compressor to run all the time, eliminating on-off cycling. Result? Smoother engine performance.

Upshift Reminder Light. When you order a Cimarron with the standard engine and five-speed manual transmission, you get an amber "upshift" reminder light. It's inside the standard tachometer dial and indicates optimum upshift timing, based on inputs from engine speed and manifold absolute pressure.

Hydraulic Clutch Release. Whichever engine you choose, you get a hydraulic clutch release with the manual transmission. Unlike the cable, hydraulic fluid provides a smoother, more consistent rate of clutch engagement, along with improved isolation from engine sounds.

Balanced. Responsive. Quick. The 1986 Cimarron offers balanced performance whether you choose the standard 2.0 liter four-cylinder engine or the available 2.8 Liter MFI V6.

Its suspension is responsive, whether it's the standard Touring Suspension with the 2.0 Liter four-cylinder engine or the gas-charged suspension required when you order the available 2.8 Liter MFI V6.

And it is satisfyingly quick to drive, turn, stop and handle. Which, after all, is what you expect from Cimarron, the Cadillac of smaller cars.

A WORD ABOUT ASSEMBLY, COMPONENTS AND OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT IN THESE CADILLAC PRODUCTS.

The Cadillacs described in this brochure are assembled at facilities operated by General Motors. These vehicles incorporate thousands of different components produced by car groups and various component divisions of General Motors and by various suppliers to General Motors worldwide. From time to time during the manufacturing process, it may be necessary, in order to meet public demand for particular vehicles or equipment, or to meet federally mandated emissions, safety and fuel economy requirements, or for other reasons, to produce Cadillac products with different components or differently sourced components than initially scheduled. All such components have been approved for use in Cadillac products and will provide the quality performance associated with the Cadillac name.

With respect to extra-cost optional equipment, make certain you specify the type of equipment you desire on your vehicle when ordering it from your dealer.
