Stylish, powerful, spacious, safe: that's today's Chrysler Alpine.



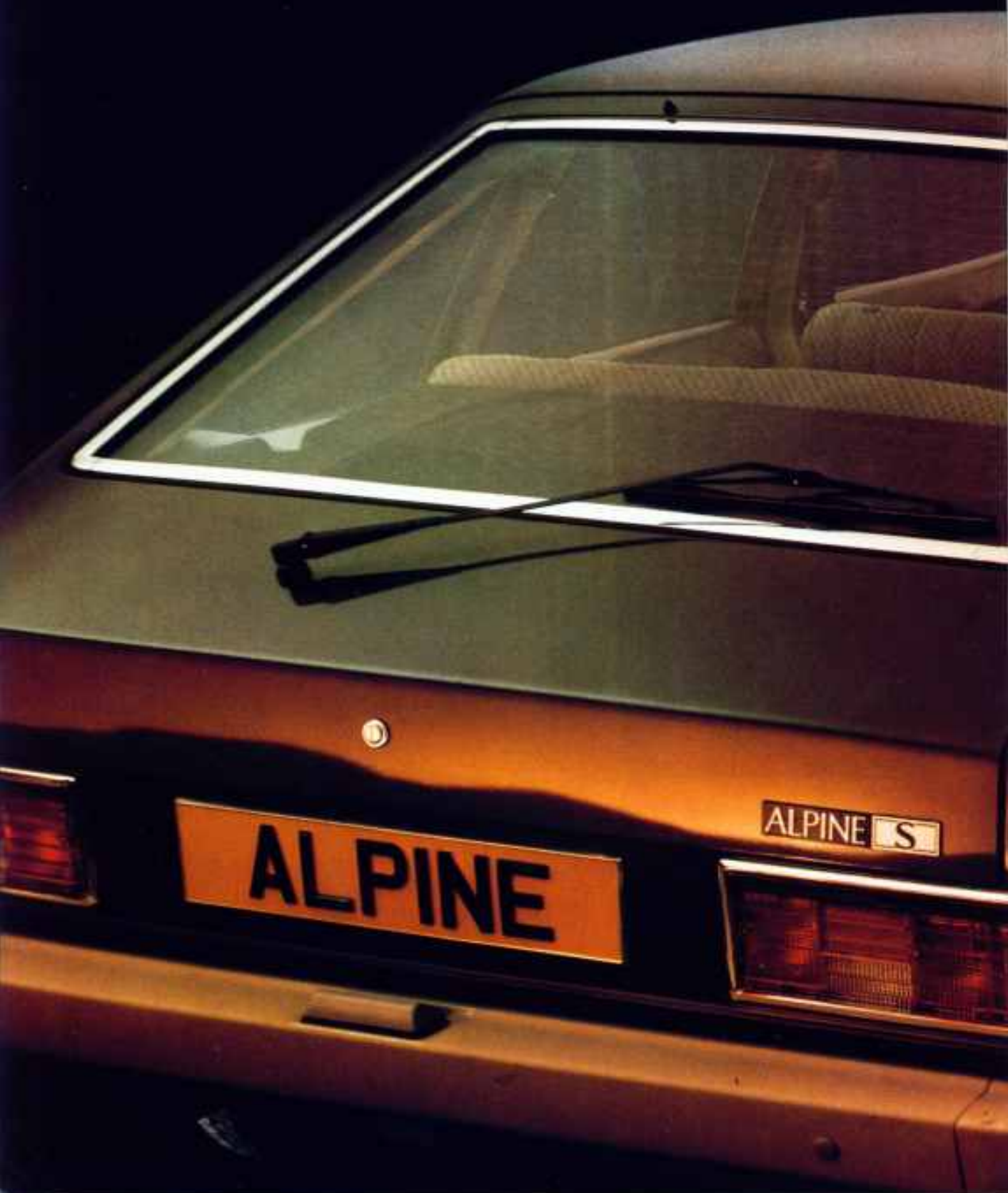
Chrysler Alpine GL

Energy-absorbing bumpers, dual circuit

servo-assisted brakes and rear fog lamps give you
security of another sort, and the handsome side
moulding protects you from knocks and bumps.

Luggage is safely hidden under the big



parcel shelf: there's a light to help you load and unload. Your back-seat passengers have their own ducted heating, and a centre armrest, as well as armrests on the doors.

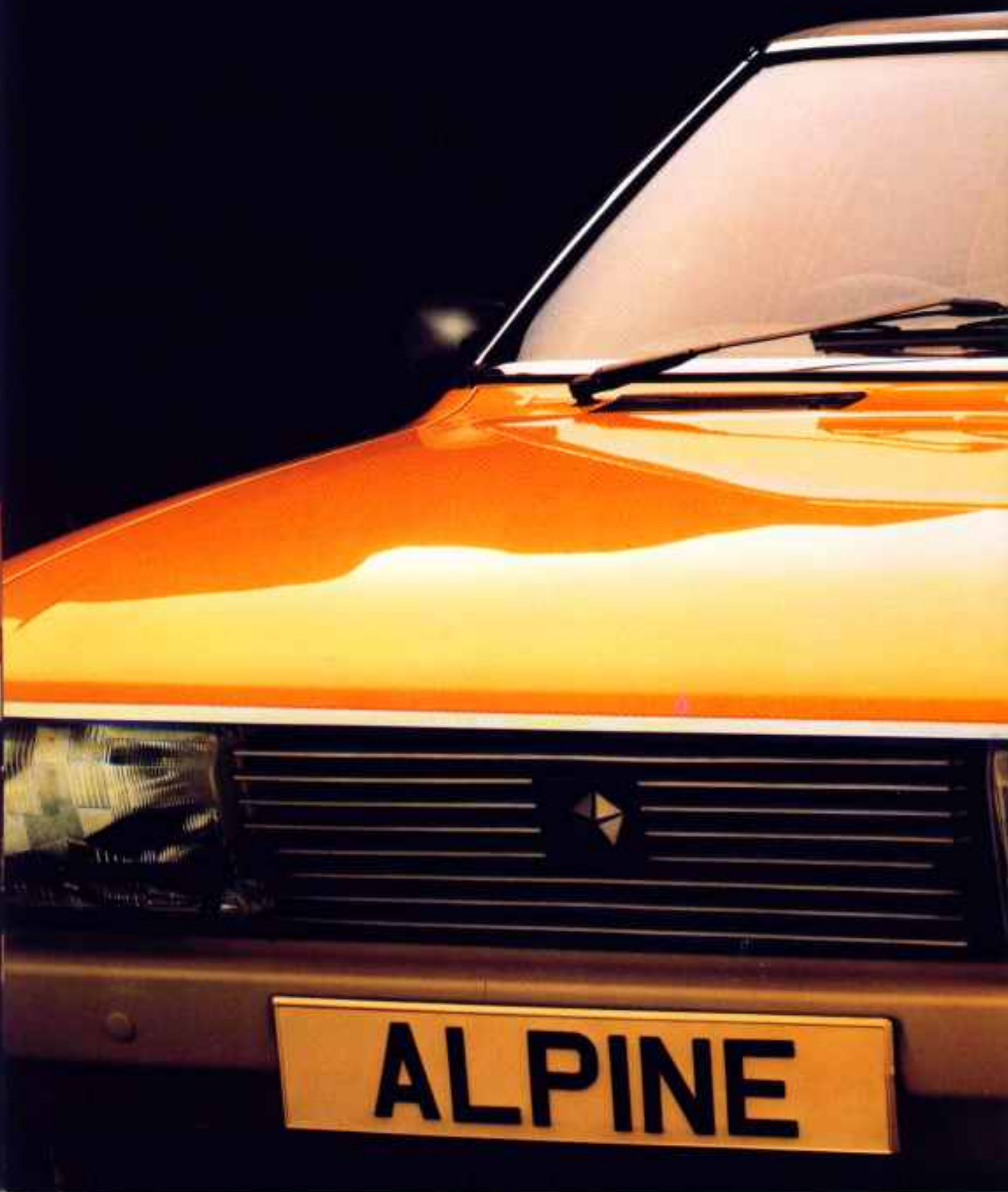
Twin-speaker radio, centre console, rheostat panel light and a lockable glovebox with its own light, and load-adjustable halogen headlamps, are other refinements built into Chrysler Alpine S.

Top speed up to 102 mph, 0-60 in around 13.2 seconds. Yet returning up to 39.8 miles to the gallon*. All this, thanks to the super-efficient 1442 cc transverse-mounted, front wheel drive engine (you'll also find it

in the S, and as an option to the 1294 cc engine with the GL). It out-performs many 1600s, with the economy you'd normally expect from a baby car. GLS distinguishing marks are smart black



vinyl-covered roof, headlamp wash/wipers, tinted glass all round, laminated windscreen, electrically operated front windows, and adjustable head restraints.

You've got your own sound system: a radio/stereo cassette player.

And you won't miss a note, even at GLS speeds, the ride is so smooth and quiet.

In addition there is a 'Low maintenance battery.'

Touch the door switches to open the front windows. Adjust the sophisticated heating and

ventilation to ideal levels: your passengers in the back have heating too. Switch on the radio/stereo cassette player.

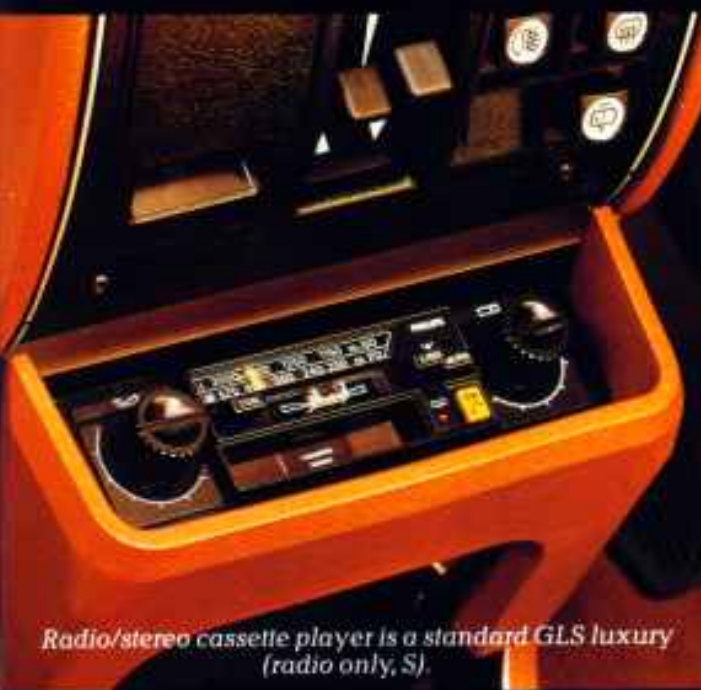

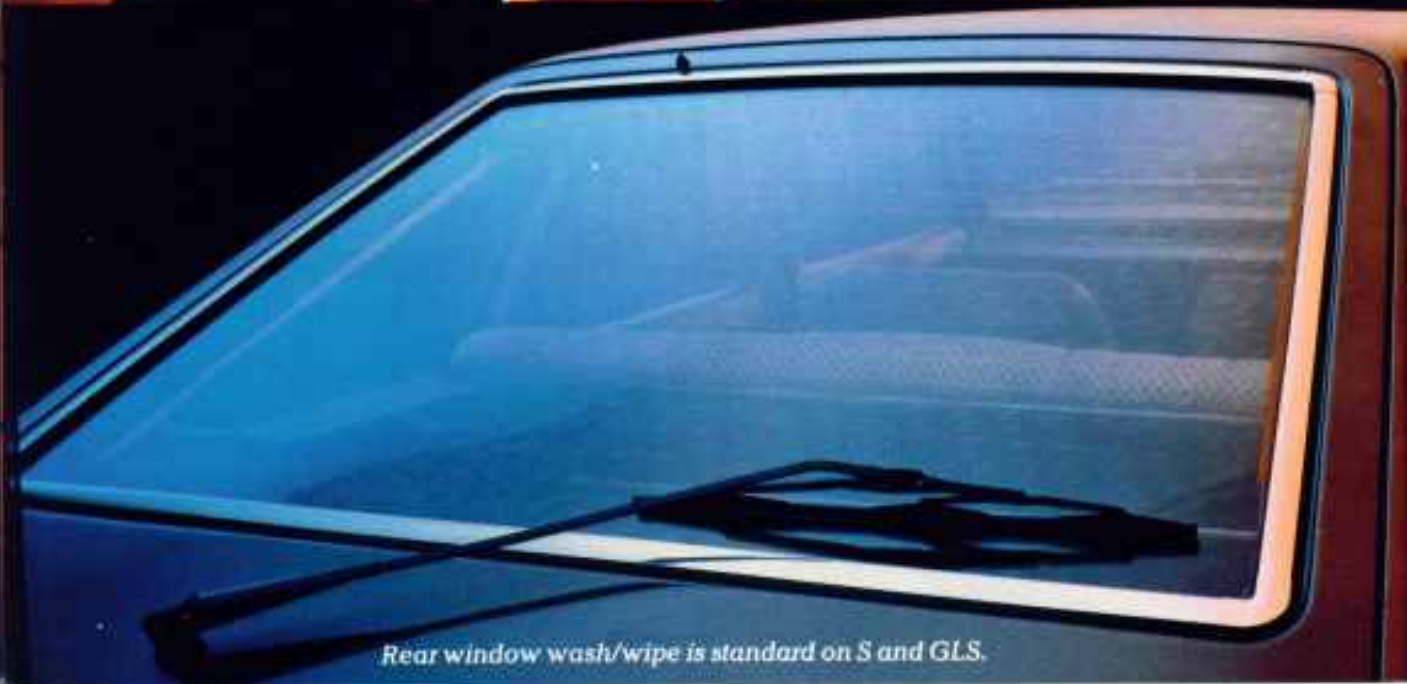
Cockpit view of the clear, comprehensive instrumentation (GLS)



Radio/stereo cassette player is a standard GLS luxury (radio only, S).



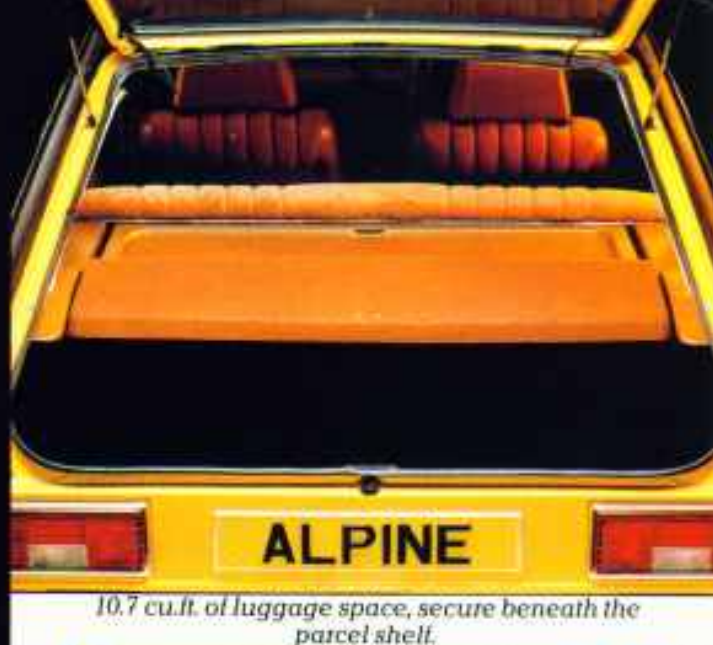
Headlamp wash/wiper is a GLS feature.



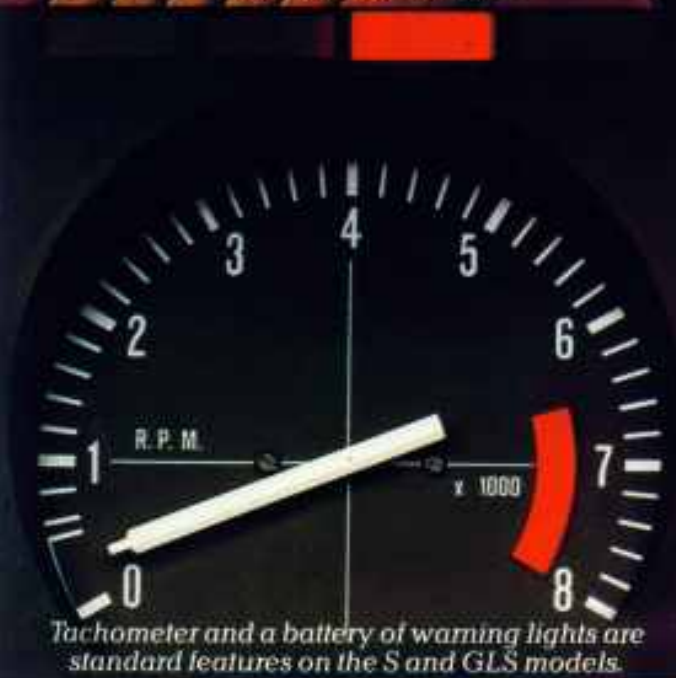
Rear window wash/wipe is standard on S and GLS.



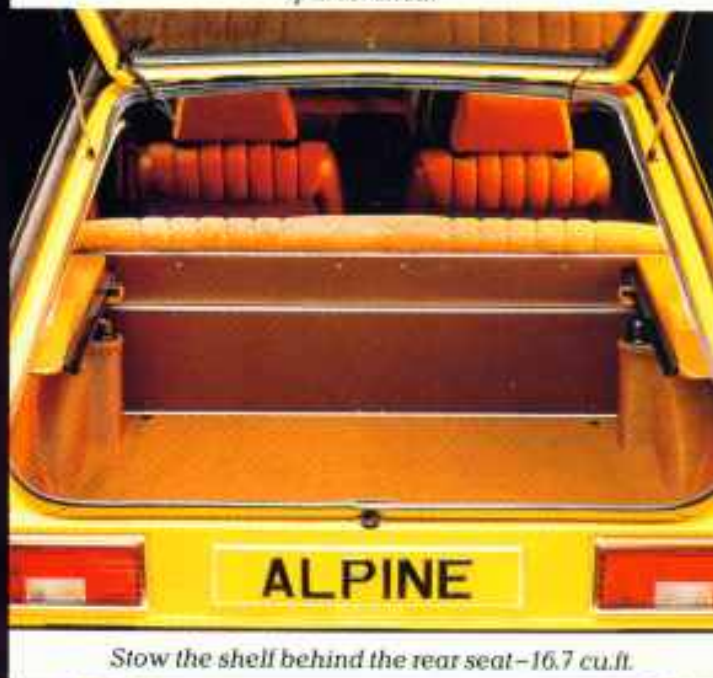
Head restraints on the GLS adjust and lock into position (optional, GL and S).

Four cylinder, live bearing crankshaft unit with aluminium alloy cylinder head, compression ratio 9.5:1.

Ignition

Electronic system to ensure constant ignition performance. 12 volt 40 amp/hour battery negative earth system, coil and distributor with automatic centrifugal and vacuum control, 14 mm sparking plugs, alternator charging.

Cooling

Water cooled, closed circuit with expansion bottle. Electrically operated cooling fan.

Transmission

Front wheel drive. Four speed all synchromesh gearbox with centre floor gear change lever 181 mm (7.1 in) diameter single dry plate clutch with hydraulic operation from pendant pedal.

Front Suspension

Independent torsion bars with telescopic shock absorbers. Anti-roll bar.

Rear Suspension

Independent coil springs with telescopic shock absorbers. Anti-roll bar.

Steering

Rack and pinion type. Turning circle 10.4 m (34.1 ft)

Brakes

240 mm (9.5 in) diameter disc at front. 228 mm (9 in) diameter drum at rear with automatic adjustment. Hydraulic dual circuit, vacuum servo assisted. Brake circuit test button and failure warning light mounted on fascia.

Wheels

Styled pressed steel. Spare wheel located under luggage compartment.

Tyres

155 x 13 radial ply.

Petrol Tank

60 litre (13.2 gallon) capacity, located at rear.

Instruments

GL Speedometer, fuel gauge, water temperature gauge, odometer with trip recorder, warning lights for ignition, oil

level/pressure, trafficator, low fuel level, side lamps, main beam, brake failure, brake wear and choke.

S and GLS Same as GL but with the addition of rev. counter, oil pressure gauge, handbrake warning light.

GL Energy absorbing bumpers, driver's door mirror, reversing lamps, hazard warning flashers, food adjustable headlamps, heated rear window, 2-speed screen wipers with flick/wipe, electric screen wash, carpet floor covering, 2-speed heater/blower, reclining front seats, fold down rear seat, glovebox, fascia parcel shelf, clock, 4-armrests, cigar lighter, soft rim steering wheel, dipping rear view mirror, sunvisors with passenger vanity mirror, face level ventilation, passenger grab handles, rear fog lamps.

S Same as GL but with the addition of halogen headlamps, panel light rheostat, centre console, rear compartment heating, rear seat centre armrest, lockable glovebox with lamp, load area lamp, tailgate wash/wipe, protective body side mouldings, radio.

GLS Same as GL and S but with the addition of headlamp wash/wipe, tinted window glass, laminated windscreen, front seat head restraints, electric front windows, radio/stereo cassette.

Diagnostic Plug

To ensure accurate timing settings, provision has been made for an electromagnetic probe to be connected to the engine during servicing giving the facility to measure the exact firing point on all four cylinders. This results in more efficient engine operation and aids fuel economy.

The Protector* and 10,000 mile servicing

Like all Chrysler cars, your Chrysler Alpine carries the double cover of 'The Protector', with 12 months' unlimited mileage warranty, and free replacement of these major parts - clutch unit, clutch plate, brake discs and pads, brake drums and linings, exhaust, shock absorbers - should they wear out during the warranty period, irrespective of the number of miles driven*.

Major servicing is required only at 10,000 miles or 12 monthly intervals, with an oil change and brake fluid check at 5,000 miles or six months.

Ask your Chrysler dealer for full details. *Cars used for Police and taxi work are excluded from free part replacement. Cars used for competitions are excluded from all the benefits of 'The Protector'.
