and exterior mirror caps in Melting Silver provide an elegant contrast to each exterior colour, with classic MINI Seven bonnet stripes in silver, flanked by Malt Brown pinstripes, rounding off the design. The exterior colour illustrated here is the standard MINI Yours Lapisluxury Blue. The new MINI Seven is also available in Pepper White, British Racing Green and Midnight Black.



You know the new MINI Seven when you see it, thanks to 17" MINI Seven light alloy wheels in two-tone or 18" MINI Yours Vanity Spoke light alloy wheels in two-tone, specially designed Seven edition side scuttles, the Melting Silver roof and the exterior colour MINI Yours Lapisluxury Blue. The latter was inspired by the shade of ultramarine, once made from fine pigments of the semiprecious stone lapis lazuli.



Sit back and savour an interior that offers style and comfort in equal measure. The MINI Yours seats upholstered in exclusive Carbon Black Lounge leather (included in the MINI Seven Chili Pack) are meticulously crafted for a unique aesthetic indulgence. They also come with braided edging, and the Union Jack design is stitched on the back of the headrests. The armrests in the doors and cockpit knee roll below the decorative surface are finished in Carbon Black, and the decorative trims and door ellipses come in stylish Piano Black. Optional features can be added to the new MINI Seven, such as Head-up Display, as well as Media Pack XL, which includes MINI Navigation System XL, an 8.8" screen, voice control, 3D mapping, MINI Connected and MINI Connected XL Journey Mate app, 20 GB music Hard Drive and enhanced Bluetooth with USB audio.

² All MINI models comply with the EU6 exhaust emissions standard. Fuel consumption is determined in accordance with the ECE driving cycle (as defined in directive 80/1268/EEC), made up of approximately one third urban and two thirds extra-urban driving (based on the distance covered). CO₂ emissions are measured separately from fuel consumption. Figures relate to vehicles with standard specification, and may vary significantly where optional equipment (including wider tyres) is fitted. Figures for fuel consumption and CO₂ emissions may vary depending on the wheels and tyres fitted.
