NEW 'RUSTGARD' PROCESS:
Key panel areas throughout the car receive special coatings of zinc-rich primer before assembly, to stop corrosion before it starts. Then follows a multi-stage cleaning, degreasing and hot phosphating operation, after which the assembled body is dipped in primer for complete underside protection. In addition platisol, bituminous and a new anti-corrosion compound are applied to seal out water and dust. The expensive new 'Dur-Ni' process dramatically increases rust resistance in chromework.

THE GMH WARRANTY protects your Premier for the first 12 months or 12,000 miles, whichever arrives first. In addition, the GMH Guardian Maintenance Plan provides for free inspection and adjustment by your Holden Dealer at the first 2,000 miles, and provides details of recommended maintenance and the labour times to 50,000 miles.
