Inside, an abundance of lush, color-keyed trim, including the deep-foam seats and cut-pile carpeting, the instrument panel, steering column and steering wheel, even the sunshade and headliner.

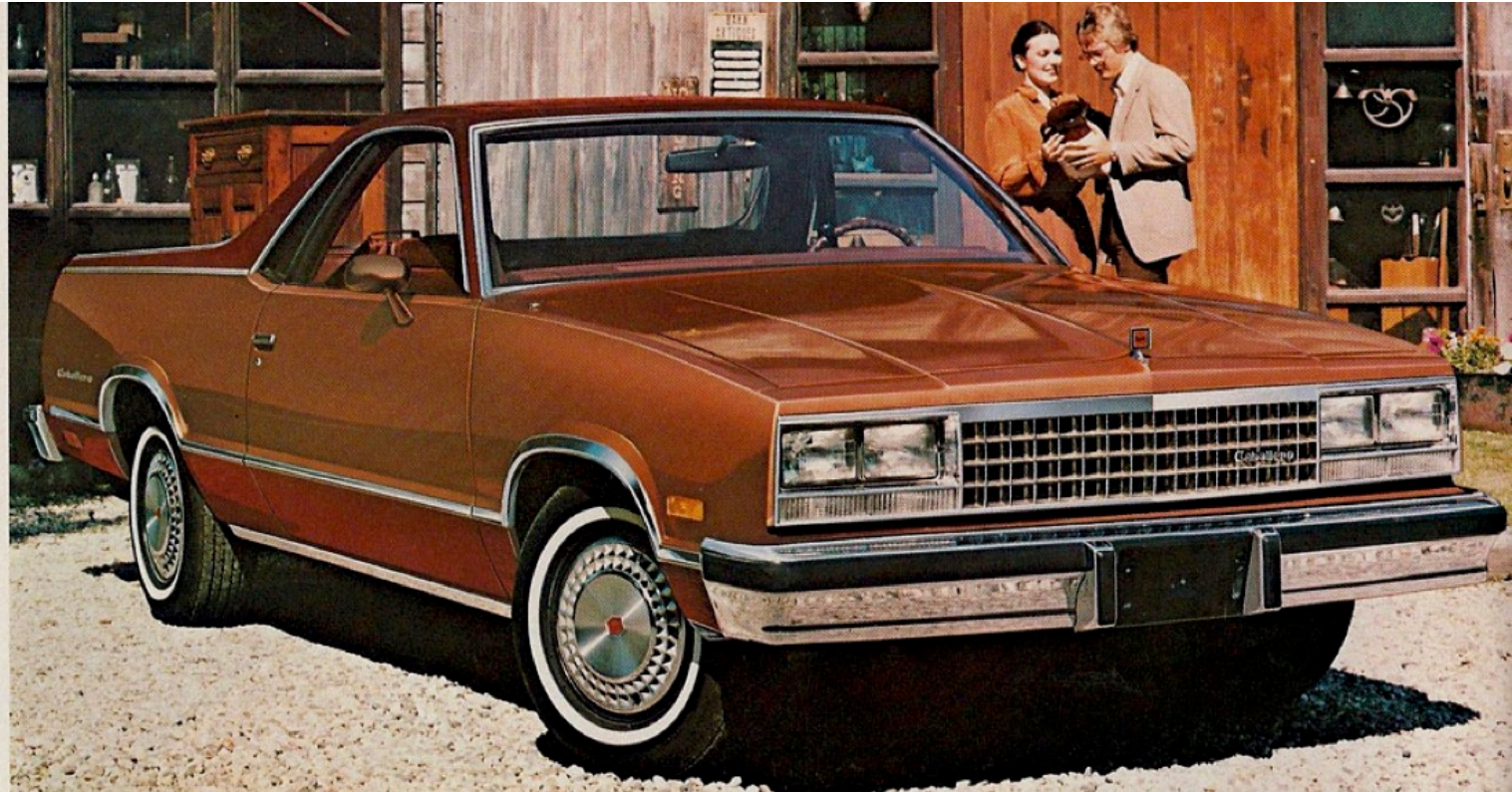
There's a new, notchback 3-passenger bench seat with centre folding armrest for both the standard and available trim levels (bucket seats can be ordered).

There's also a sporty new instrument cluster and panel treatment with round instruments and smart, woodgrain applique.

And, for car-like convenience, there's a new "smart switch" on the steering column with multi-function controls for turn signals, headlamp dimmer and windshield wiper/washer (also will control available intermittent windshield wipers and automatic speed/cruise control).

And all this, remember, is yours in a truck!

Truckin' never had it so good.

GMC believes that there should be a vehicle offering the best of both worlds: the pampering touches of a well-equipped automobile and the tough work-habits of a pickup.

Hence: GMC Caballero.

In addition to the niceties mentioned on the previous page, the passenger compartment comes with door trim panels with integral padded armrests and door pull straps, there's a deluxe-air heater/defroster, door-activated courtesy lights, lighted ash-tray and glove box, foam-backed cloth headliner and concealed storage for luggage and spare tire behind the driver's seat.

Caballero Diablo. An available and devilishly-attractive Caballero with the hood top sporting a striking scroll motif of the Devil ("Diablo"). Two-tone exterior offers a choice of seven color combinations with color-keyed vinyl pinstriping covering the paint break line. Sport mirrors are upper-body color. And new Rally wheels are standard. "Diablo" identification tells people you're having devil-may-care fun.

Caballero Amarillo. This is the definitive sport or executive pickup. Offering distinctive two-tone paint in a choice of eight color combinations, plus bright paint-break moldings on the body sides and tailgate.

It's hard to believe that this luxury and sportiness comes with the box of a half-ton pickup (although more gracefully contoured). What's more, double-walled construction helps keep minor nicks or dents on the inner box from marring the handsome outer finish.

Features for 1982 include power steering, power-assisted disc/drum power brakes with audible wear indicator, (low-drag front disc brakes are new), maintenance-free Freedom II battery, electronic High Energy ignition, a tough exhaust system, and computer-selected, full-coil suspension with air-adjustable shocks.

The front disc brakes with new low-drag calipers are designed to reduce friction and help fuel efficiency.

There are also new, dual cowl-mounted "fluidic" windshield washers to provide a fan spray for effective cleaning. Fender-mounted mast-type antenna for available radios permits improved fringe-area reception. Antenna can be unscrewed and taken in for protection while in a car wash or when parked on the street.

All Caballero models now have three-speed automatic transmission coupled with either the standard 2-bbl., 3.8 litre V6 or available 2-bbl., 4.4 litre V8 or 4-bbl., 5.0 litre V8.

Computer Command Control Emission System

All 1982 V8 engines for GMC Caballero are available with the computer-controlled system that reduces Caballero's emissions to the lowest level in GMC history. Space-age technology employs an on-board computer, an oxygen sensor, other engine sensors, and an electromechanical fuel metering system in the carburetor to control the ratio of fuel/air induction. The system is also engineered so the engine will continue to function in the event of a computer malfunction.

Trailering with Caballero

Tour in style and take along your own overnight accommodations. Standard Caballero with a dealer-installed deadweight hitch can tow a 2,000-lb (loaded) trailer. With the 5.0 litre V8 engine and available weight-distributing hitch platform, you can tow trailers up to 5,000 lbs.
