## Challenger. The form measures up to the challenge.

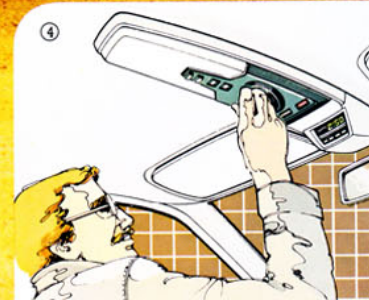
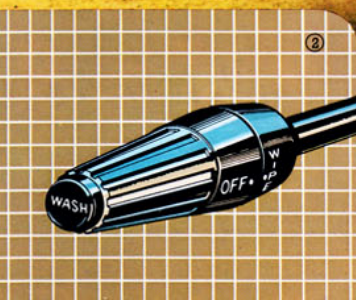
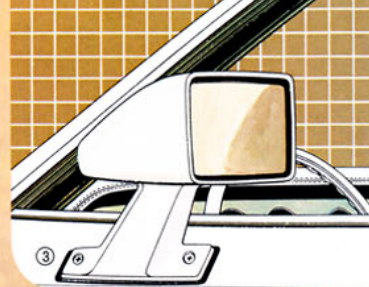
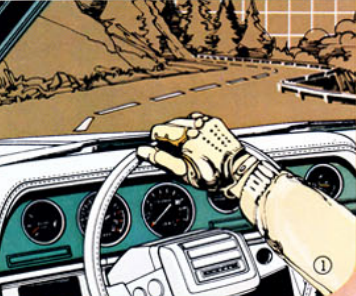
Every time you take the wheel in your own two hands, you accept the challenge the open road imparts. It's an exciting proposition. Enter Challenger, a car in complete accord with that philosophy. Whose nameplate aptly describes car and driver. An automobile based upon the premise that driving should never lack imagination. Anymore than a car's looks or road capabilities. Challenger is an extraordinary blend of both. A handsomely equipped two-plus-two **grand tourer** that plays the part beautifully.

- 1. Take command.** Here is where you assume control of road or track: a sport steering wheel wrapped in simulated leather.
- 2. Magic switch.** A single lever on the steering column incorporates turn indicator, headlight dimmer, and windshield wash/wipe controls.
- 3. Look back at the crowd.** Dual body-colored racing mirrors are power remote-control.
- 4. Light at the top.** Overhead console features a pivotal reading lamp and three-way dome light switch.

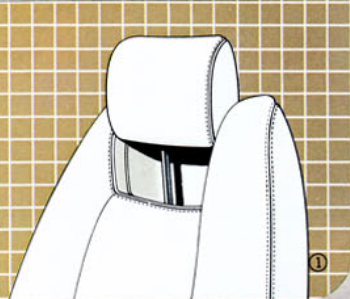
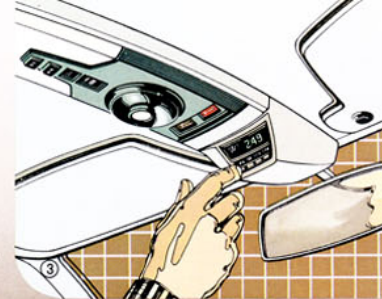
Challenger in Spitfire Orange and Silver.



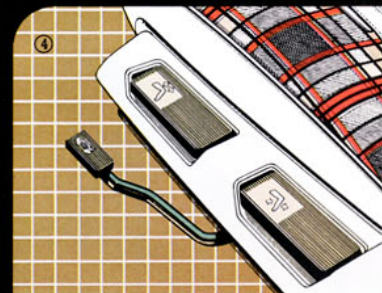
## You are now entering Challenger control.

The adventure continues. The feeling within is consistent with the aerodynamics without. Driver and passenger comfort is provided by dual reclining front bucket seats with lumbar supports and concealed adjustable headrests. Full instrumentation is set behind an easy-to-grip sport steering wheel while cool is maintained by way of power flow-through ventilation and tinted glass all around. In total, singular surroundings for a very advanced mode of transit.

- 1. Heads up.** Headrests fit flush into Challenger's bucket seats until adjusted to the personal preference of driver or passenger.
- 2. Sit right.** For comfortable seating posture, Challenger bucket seats offer adjustable lumbar supports and reclining seat-backs.
- 3. Time travel.** An overhead digital clock tells you the time as you travel.
- 4. Powers of recall.** Unique walk-in adjuster with memory returns the passenger seat to a neutral position after rear seat passengers have entered. Driver's side (shown) features a remote trunk-lid release.



Instrumentation is easy to read, includes speedometer, tachometer, resettable trip odometer as well as temperature, oil, fuel, and ammeter gauges. AM/FM radio or AM/FM stereo with tape system are available options.

## The force behind the challenge.

Challenger's unique shape and ultramodern control center are only the beginning. Underneath, there is the technology to match. You are free to choose the standard 1.6-litre or optional 2.6-litre overhead-cam Silent Shaft MCA-Jet engine. Either power plant delivers smooth, quiet, and animated performance whether coupled to the standard five-speed manual or the optional TorqueFlite automatic transmission. Big 193/70HRx14" steel-belted radial-ply tires are mounted to striking 14-inch cast aluminum wheels. Suspension is coil-type with road-seasoned MacPherson-type struts up front and

four-link coils with a straight live axle in the rear. Braking is provided by the standard power front disc/rear drum system or an optional system that boasts power disc brakes on all four wheels.

But make no mistake. Challenger is only the means. The real challenger is you.

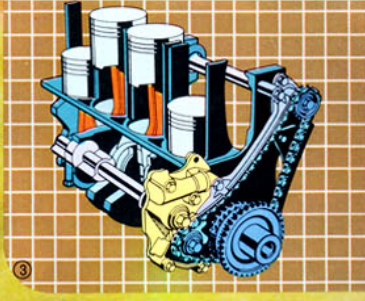
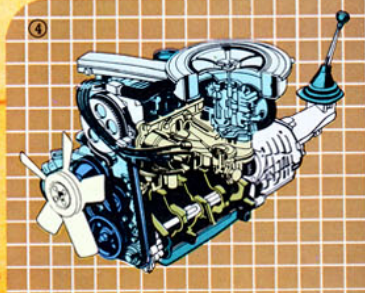
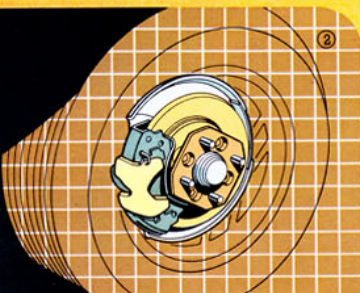
1. **Smooth and sure.** Challenger's standard five-speed allows for smooth, precise shifting in whatever the situation.
2. **Challenger stops here.** Braking is accomplished by the standard power front disc/rear drum system or optional four-wheel power disc brakes.
3. **Clean and quiet.** Challenger's

standard 1.6- and optional 2.6-litre Silent Shaft Mitsubishi engines feature the MCA (Mitsubishi Clean Air)-Jet System that promotes more efficient combustion by inducing a swirling extra-lean mixture. Counterbalancing shafts reduce noise and vibration caused by piston movements and explosive cylinder shocks.

4. **What's more . . .** Both the standard 1.6-litre and optional 2.6-litre engines feature a two-barrel carburetor, single exhaust, five-bearing crankshaft, aluminum cylinder heads, hemispherical combustion chambers, overhead-cam, and automatic choke.
