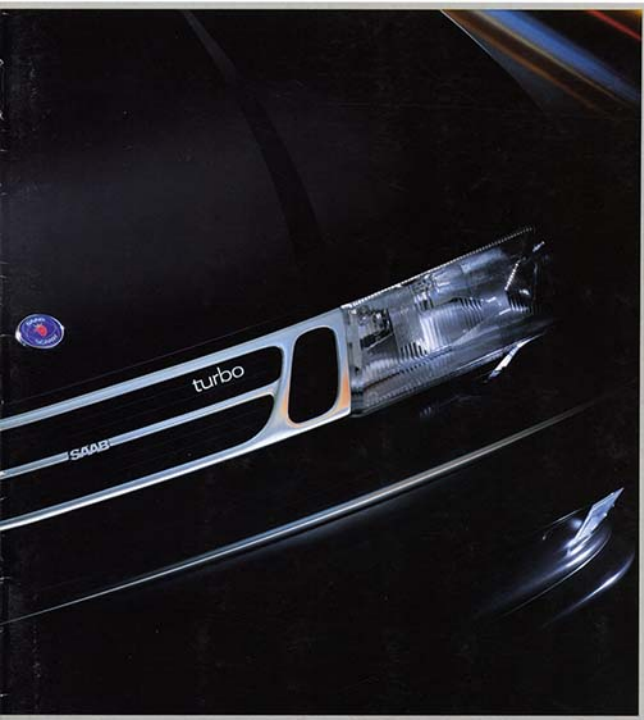

# Innovation is our tradition



The first Saab car, the Saab 92, was launched in 1947. The aircraft is a Saab J21.



The first Saab cars were designed by Swedish aircraft engineers with little regard for conventional car design. They created overall designs based on functional aspects rather than fashion trends. These men started a tradition of independent thinking at Saab. This unusual way of approaching car design has resulted in Saab's technological edge and innovative tradition.

**D**esign trends and preconceived ideas never dictate the shape of a Saab. The overall function of the car, as well as its every detail, provide the most important aspect. That's what gives Saab its character.

Our cars are built with the driver and passengers in mind. For this reason we use natural, yet aerodynamic designs—which lead to tough yet lightweight cars. Aircraft are also designed in much the same way.

The body of the Saab 9000CS has very high torsional rigidity. This contributes to a low interior noise level, good driving characteristics and a high level of passive safety.



Most drivers spend on average three or four weeks a year in a car. Thus the car has to be functional under all circumstances and able to cope with different user requirements.

## Torque—the foundation for Saab's engine development



In 1986, three Saab 900's ran at full throttle for 20 days on a racetrack at Talladega, USA. They broke 21 international records, including two world records. A good proof of Saab's endurance.



On the road, a Saab displays a blend of agility and stability rarely found in other cars. There are all sorts of technical explanations. What you experience is the feeling of composure and control at all times. "It's the sort of car that inspires confidence", wrote Autocar.

# Saab 9000 CS

The 9000 CS is the latest manifestation of Saab's individuality. And made in the tradition that function should govern form. The low front and the distinctive, rounded rear end gives the 9000 CS a marked wedge shape.

The engine range includes a 2.3-litre turbo engine and a 2.3-litre injection engine.

With Saab's 147 kW, 2.3-litre turbo engine, the 9000 CS has a top speed of 230 km/h. In fourth gear it accelerates from 60 to 100 km/h in just 6.6 secs, faster than almost any other car. This is the result of an engine developing a maximum torque of 330 Nm even at 1900 rpm.

The high torsional rigidity of the body has allowed us to tune the chassis for the

best possible combination of comfort and driving characteristics. At the same time body stiffness contributes to a very high passive safety and an even lower noise level in the interior.

The Saab 9000 CSE has the 2.3-litre turbo engine and a whole range of comfort features, offering the most comfortable travelling environment imaginable. The ergonomically designed seats are clad with leather specially treated to meet Saab's stringent demands for quality. Standard features include Automatic Climate Control (ACC), electrically operated windows, electrically adjustable and heated exterior rear-view mirrors, automatic cruise control and rear wash/wipe.



The driver environment is ergonomically planned and easy to scan. Automatic Climate Control (ACC), Saab Car Computer (SCC) and electrically adjustable front seats are examples of available features.

# Saab 9000 CD

The Saab 9000 CD puts the emphasis on comfort. And yet it is essentially a driving machine, appreciated by drivers in the know. The 4-door chassis, with the most spacious boot of any car in its class, gives the 9000 CD a classical, almost sober touch.

The engine range includes two powerful alternatives. The 147 kW, 2.3-litre turbo engine develops an impressive 330 Nm of torque at a low 1900 rpm. So valuable seconds are gained when overtaking compared to most other cars. Alternatively there is a 110 kW, 2.3-litre injection engine.

If you're looking for a car which offers comfort over and above the ordinary, there is always the Saab 9000 CD with the 2.3-litre injection engine. The seats are

leather upholstered and the standard equipment includes electrically operated windows and electrically adjustable and heated exterior rear-view mirrors.

At the top of the range you find the Saab 9000 Griffin, an exceptionally well equipped car with a range of features which only have one function—to make your journey as comfortable as possible. The seats are covered with Saab's exclusive full-leather upholstery. A very interesting alternative is upholstery consisting of exclusive woollen fabric supplied by the Italian family company Ermenegildo Zegna. The exclusive upholstery is complemented by a beautiful burr walnut interior trim.



Wool is a natural fabric eminently suitable to serve as car upholstery. It reacts well to different temperatures, is water-repellent, and tolerant to grime. # Saab 900 Convertible

Anyone who has driven a convertible on a hot summers day wants to do it again. For many people it's the only way to drive.

The Saab 900 Convertible is the classic "open top" car, for four people. The top is fully electrically operated, a feature found on few European convertibles. At the press of a button the top folds into its own storage space. When the top is up, the multi-layer fabric and the heated rear window provide excellent insulation.

With 118 kW and maximum torque of 255 Nm at 2800 rpm, the turbo model

produces breathtaking performance. The engine range also includes Saab's 2.1-litre injection model.

Comfort features include electrically heated seats, catalytic converter, the ABS anti-lock braking system, electrically operated windows and rear-view mirrors, and headrests in both rear and front seats. All these are, of course, standard.

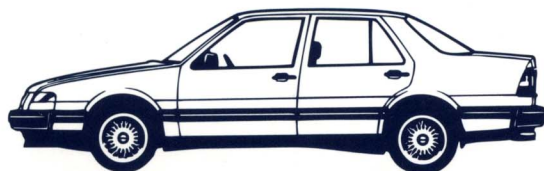
