Two versions are available: the iconic soft-top featuring a spirited 126ps 1.8-litre engine with a classic cloth roof, and the sleek Roadster Coupe featuring a 160ps 2-litre engine and a retractable hard-top. Both versions provide an exhilarating open-top, wind-in-the-hair drive. They benefit from unique premium leather seats, with the Miyako logo embossed into the headrest, and special edition floor mats. Standard features, such as climate-control air-conditioning and CD player, enhance the driving experience.
