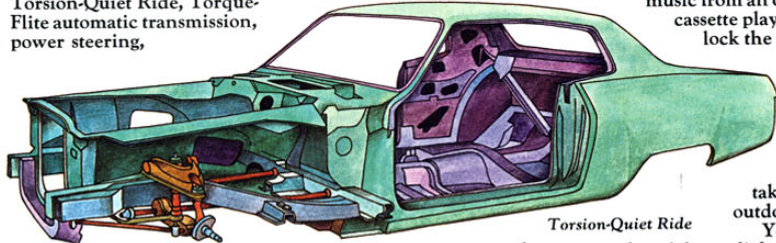


What Makes A Fury A Fury.

When you consider a Fury as your next car, you'll notice that luxury comes standard.

For example, every Fury has Torsion-Quiet Ride, Torque-Flite automatic transmission, power steering,

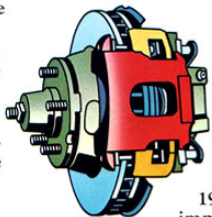
misfiring and so reduces emissions. Excluding routine spark plug service, the system is virtually maintenance free in

power front disc brakes and the Electronic Ignition System as standard equipment.

Compared to a conventional ignition system, Fury's electronic system is a hands-down winner. For example: there are no points or condenser. That means there are none to replace—so you may never have to worry about getting an ignition tune-up. The original engine timing should be good for 50,000 miles or more. You also get consistently higher voltage—by as much as 35%—for more dependable cold weather starts. It also helps eliminate many of the major causes of engine

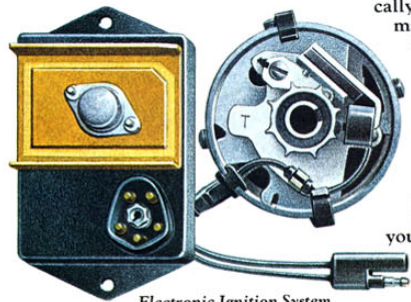
transmission fluid filter that provides a 50% increase in filtering area to improve the life of both the fluid and the transmission.

Electronically and mechanically we've done a lot to make sure your Plymouth Fury is built to last . . . built to be comfortable.

Take room for instance. Fury has one of the largest interiors in the industry.

Besides roominess, you also get comfort.

Take the driver's seat for example.

It supports you. It surrounds you with deep-foam padding. And it puts a whole world of comfort and convenience at your fingertips. Cooling from an optional air conditioner. Your choice of music from an optional stereo cassette player. You can lock the doors, roll up

the windows and enjoy the driving. With an optional sun roof you can even take in the great outdoors.

Your passenger

hasn't been slighted either. We've designed a passenger seat that offers individual separation from the driver's side. That way, everyone gets the leg room they want. We've also made passenger seats which recline in a variety of positions.

We also feel that people who sit in the back shouldn't have to take a back seat in comfort. So we've designed plenty of room

in back. Leg room. Hip room. Elbow room. And head room. Even an average six-footer won't bang his head on a Fury ceiling.

You have the option of putting speakers in the back for your radio or tape deck. If you want, you can make them stereo speakers and have a total of five.

Another comfort you will

enjoy is thick, loop-pile carpeting that covers the entire passenger compartment.

Chrysler engineers have designed an extra-protection bumper system that is capable of impacting a fixed barrier at 5 mph front,

and 2½ mph rear without significant damage.

Why do we call these bumpers "extra-protection?"

Because we've done our best to exceed the federal government's new damage standards for low-speed accidents.

Some of the ways we

accomplished this is by setting the bumper itself out from the sheet metal by as much as two inches to provide impact protection—and a full-width reinforcement is located behind the bumper surface to provide better beam strength during impact. There's also a bumper support structure using heavy-gauge steel with deep sections for added strength. And, in addition to

their impact capabilities, our elastomeric bumper guards help keep your Fury from slipping over or under another car's bumper during a low-speed collision.

To help protect the sides of the car, our Fury Gran Coupes, Gran Sedans and Fury III's come with a vinyl side molding that helps guard against dings and scrapes.

We've also done a lot to protect the car from illegal entry. All Furies have a new deck lid lock design that offers substantially increased resistance to illegal entry.

And our new Security Alarm System, available only with optional power door locks, offers additional peace of mind. This system is integrated right into



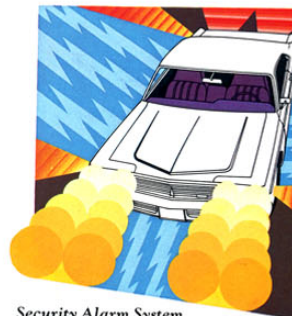
Extra-Protection Bumper System

the car's wiring system.

The system is armed by locking either front door with the ignition-door key. Once the system is armed, it can only be turned off by using the same key. If someone tampers with the hood, trunk, door or ignition the alarm is activated. This alarm starts the headlights, tail-lights and side marker lights flashing in conjunction with the horn blowing intermittently. For your convenience, entrance to the trunk with the key is allowed without violating this system.

Another option you may want to consider is our trailer-towing package. With it, and the optional 440 cu. in. engine, your Fury can tow up to 7,000 lbs. Check our 1973 Trailer-Towing Guide for details.

of automotive emissions. Emission levels for our '73 cars, as compared

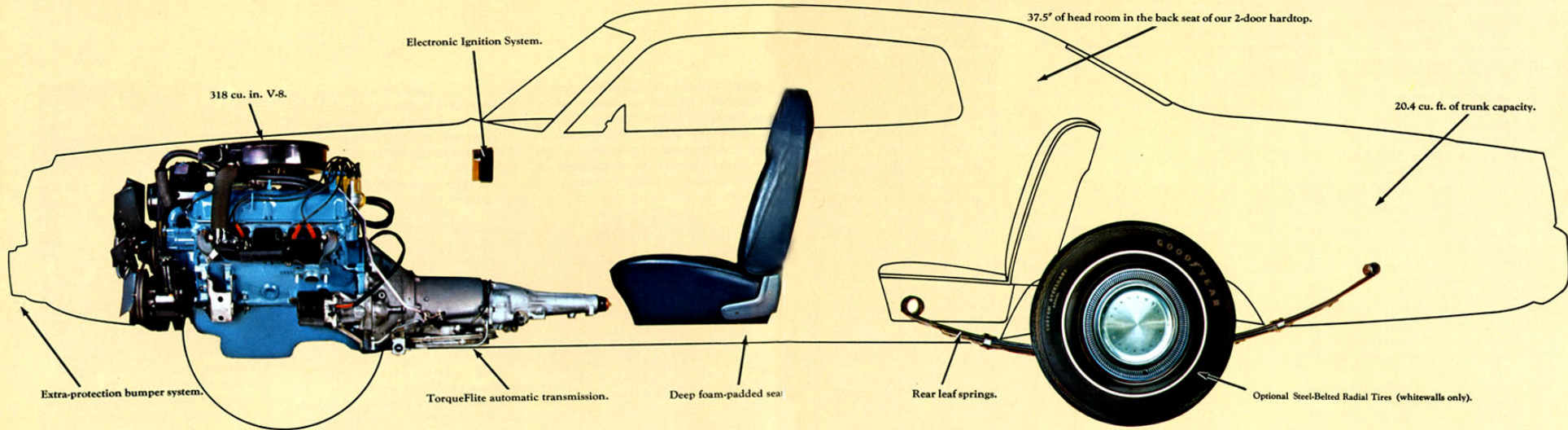

to cars having no emission controls, are as follows: Total hydrocarbons reduced by about 85%, carbon monoxide reduced by about 70%, and oxides of nitrogen by about 50%.

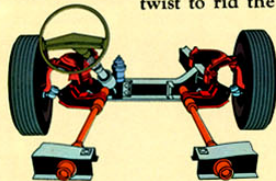

Front Torsion Bars

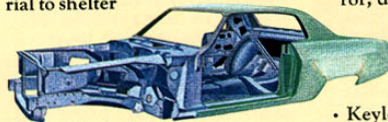
car of road shock and take the bumps out of bumpy roads.

In the rear, all Furies have long-span leaf springs with 4-point body support. The axle is mounted ahead of the center of the spring, where the thick, forward-section leaf springs help hold the car level during braking and acceleration. Also helping to stabilize the car is a front anti-sway bar and sea-leg mounted rear shock absorbers.

Our engineers also believe that unibody construction, with its over 4,000 welds, helps make the

car strong and free of rattles. You can't unbolt a Fury body from its frame. And every Fury body gets the 7-step dip-and-spray process treatment to help stop rust before it gets a chance to start.

To keep your Fury quiet, there's the Sound Isolation System. Eight rubber sound isolators separate the stub-frame from the structure of the car. And there's as much as 160 square feet of sound insulation material to shelter

you from outside noise.
